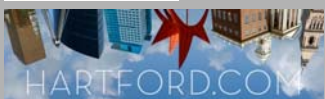

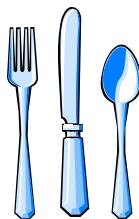

- Star Shuttle (stop #1).

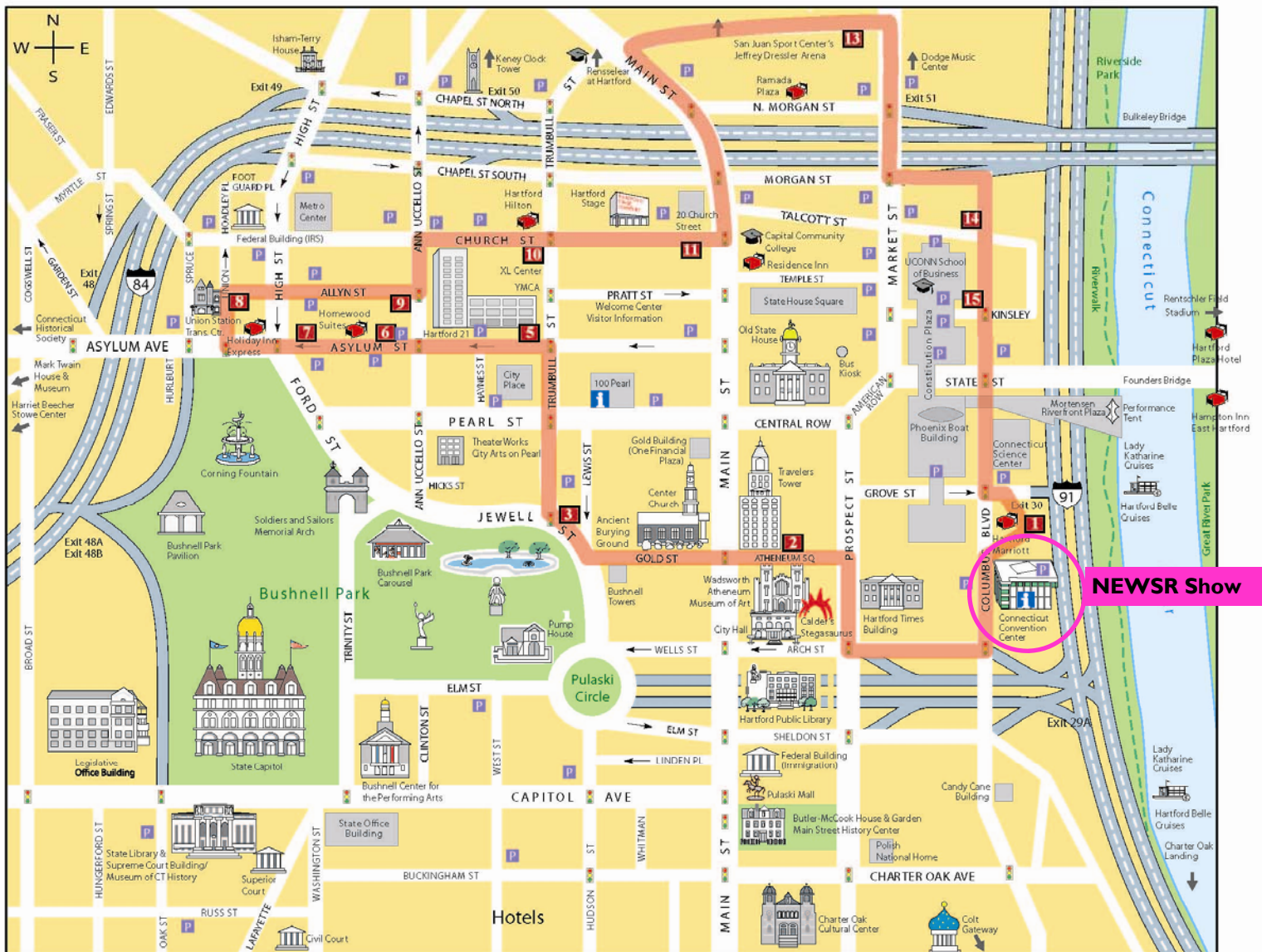

Parking Hotels



Enjoy a **FREE** ride aboard the Hartford Star Shuttle. This bus loops Downtown Hartford encouraging you to discover our many hotels, restaurants and entertainment venues. See the map above for the route, stops and operating hours. Many of our area hotels also have shuttles and could assist you, please ask your front desk for more details.



Bradley International Airport (BDL) is located about 12 miles from Hartford. Some hotels have shuttles that service the airport and/or Downtown Hartford. One-way cab fare is approximately \$42.00. Operated by CTTransit, the "Bradley Flyer" offers reliable transportation between Downtown Hartford and Bradley International Airport (BDL). The bus operates daily with stops at both the Connecticut Convention Center and Union Station. One-way fare is **just \$1.25 per person**.
